



PA Classics 2022-23 Event Support

On a yearly basis, PA Classics hosts numerous tournaments that are very beneficial to all involved with the club. Our tournaments have become very large and offer great quality to our members without the need to leave home. However, to make these tournaments continually successful we need help from parents with the normal work that goes along with their production. In the coming year, we will be asking each family to work at one (1) tournament for one (1) shift of three (3) hours per child in the club. If you have two children in the club, then we will be asking for a total of six (6) hours. No one will be asked to work more than six (6) hours. This is your "Event Support" service for the year. You have an option with "Event Support". We hope that you'll choose to support the events, but if it doesn't fit your schedule or you simply don't want to do so, then that is fine also. Once you've worked a shift of event support, we will reduce your fees by \$40, which will be deducted from the March 2023 dues cost. If you do not want to work a shift, then you will be responsible for the full cost of the March dues payment. Below is a list of the events for 2022-2023 that teams will be assigned to. All events will be held at Classics Soccer Park and fields in the immediate Lancaster County area. Each team within the club will be assigned to a particular event. Once assigned, if you cannot work on your team's scheduled event, then you can ask to be assigned another event that better fits your schedule. Roughly 2-3 weeks prior to your team's scheduled event, you will receive an email asking if you want to work your Event Support or not. If you would like to work the event, simply click on, and fill out, the e-sign up form that is included in the invitation email. If not, there is nothing more to do.

Site Coordinators:

PA Classics will also have Site Coordinator roles available for individuals interested in working for a weekend, at a set rate of \$15/hour. Typical tournaments range from 18 to 22 hours of work in a weekend. Site Coordinators are assigned to non-Classics Park venues where they will be overseeing Field Marshalls, manage on-site event operations, and work in concert with the Tournament Directors.
